GP recorded Smoking Prevalence

Smoking is a major contributor to ill health, including coronary heart disease and cancer. PSA18 (Promoting better health and wellbeing for all) includes the national target to reduce adult smoking rates to 21% or less by 2010, with a reduction in prevalence among routine and manual groups to 26% or less. Reducing smoking prevalence is crucial to delivering reductions in health inequalities and to tackling health problems in poorer communities.

This data collection is designed to provide a measure of the prevalence of smoking at a local level. There are many sources of smoking prevalence at a national level such as the General Household survey and the Health Survey for England (See links below for more details). The General Household surveys states that smoking prevalence in England was 22% in 2006, down from 28% in 1998.

Data on GP recorded smoking status was first collected in 2005/06 quarter four, when it was collected annually. Since then the collection has undergone a number of significant changes which include:

- a change in age bands to 16 and over,
- a change in collection period to quarterly and now
- the inclusion, within the number of patients with smoking status recorded, of those aged 25 and over, who have not had their smoking status recorded in the last 15 months but whose smoking status since the age of 25 was recorded as never smoked.

Primary Care Trusts (PCTs) should have plans that support the reduction of smoking, including consideration of accurate identification of smokers and provision of stop smoking advice and services. They will need to be provided in the context of an overall policy to tackle smoking, including for example increased prescribing of stop smoking products to support people who want to stop smoking. Plans should target at-risk groups, including those with co-morbidity and groups with higher prevalence rates.

Each PCT is required to submit three figures each quarter:

- Total number of patients on the register aged 16 and over (Line 7108),
- Total number of people aged 16 and over on GP register with smoking status recorded in the last 15 months (Line 4263) and
- Total number of people aged 16 and over on GP register recorded as being a smoker in the last 15 months (Line 4264).

All three numbers must be submitted as integers. Logic suggests that the following rules should apply to the data submitted. All validation checks must be passed in order for the data to meet departmental statistical requirements. This indicator will be validated to one decimal point.

Anecdotal evidence suggests that many GP practices are only recording the smoking status of those who smoke or the return is based on a small sample of patients. This can lead to unrepresentative estimates of prevalence, which clouds our understanding of the situation relating to this key morbidity factor. If the percentage of patients whose smoking status is recorded is less than 70%, the data will not be used to assess progress and will not be reported. We realise that not all PCTs will be able to meet the 70% coverage criteria instantly. However, we have been collecting this data for four years, so coverage should at least be approaching the required coverage criteria. To ensure coverage requirements are met, PCTs should ensure that those persons who have never smoked are recorded as non-smokers.

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The NHS Information Centre for health and social care commissioned the National Centre for Social Research to produce model-based estimates of healthy lifestyle behaviours, using information from the Health Survey for England (HSE). This included estimates of smoking prevalence among adults.

These model-based estimates are used to check the figures for GP-recorded smoking prevalence. In doing so, account is taken of the confidence intervals for the model-based estimates and the time that has elapsed between the collection of the HSE data and the GP-recorded data. The validation rules are as follows:

At quarter 4 2008/09, One PCTs did not supply a complete set of information. A further 4 failed the GP register criteria. 55 did not meet the 70% coverage criteria and 53 achieved 70% coverage but reported a prevalence estimate inconsistent with the model-based estimate.

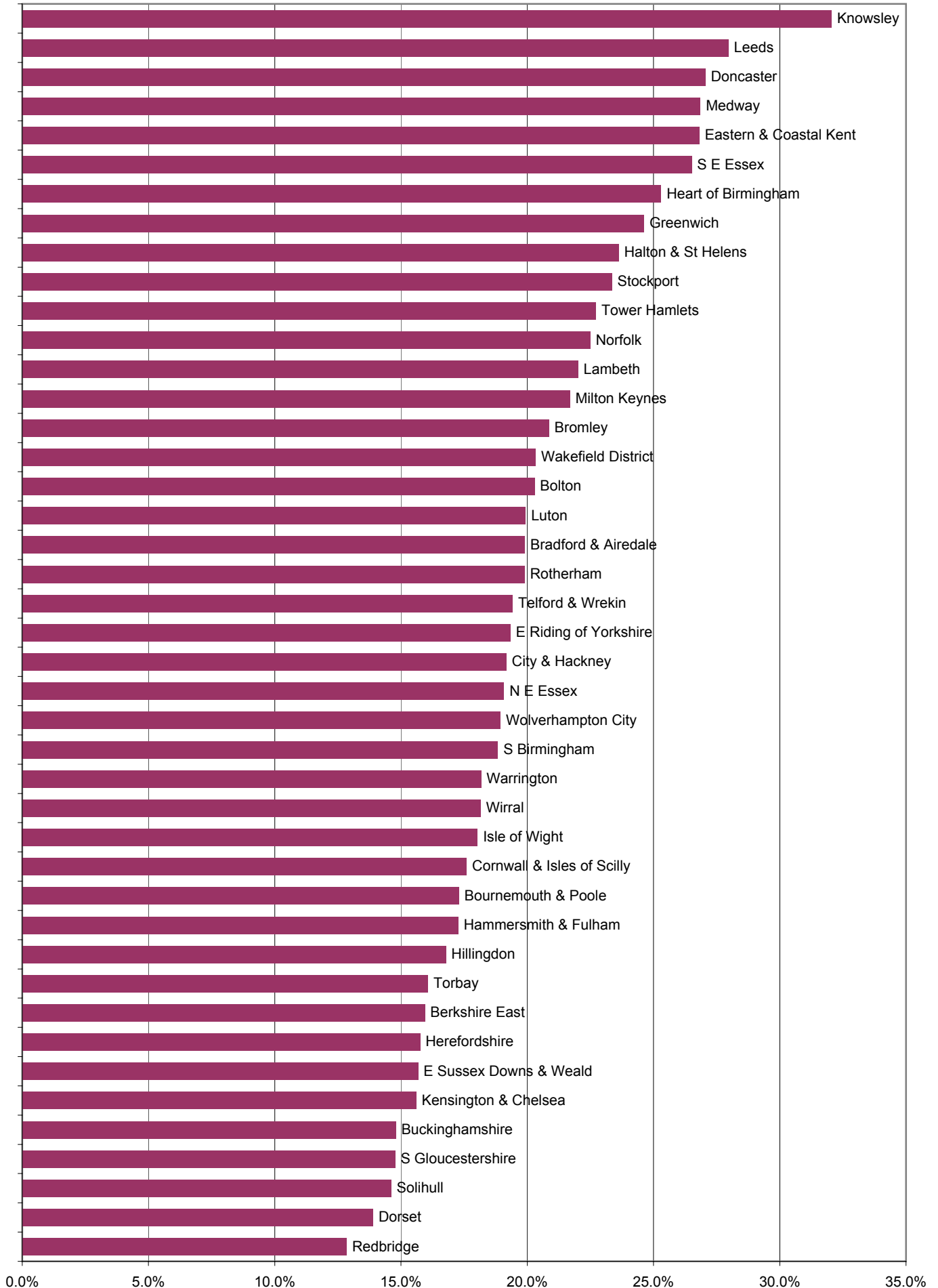

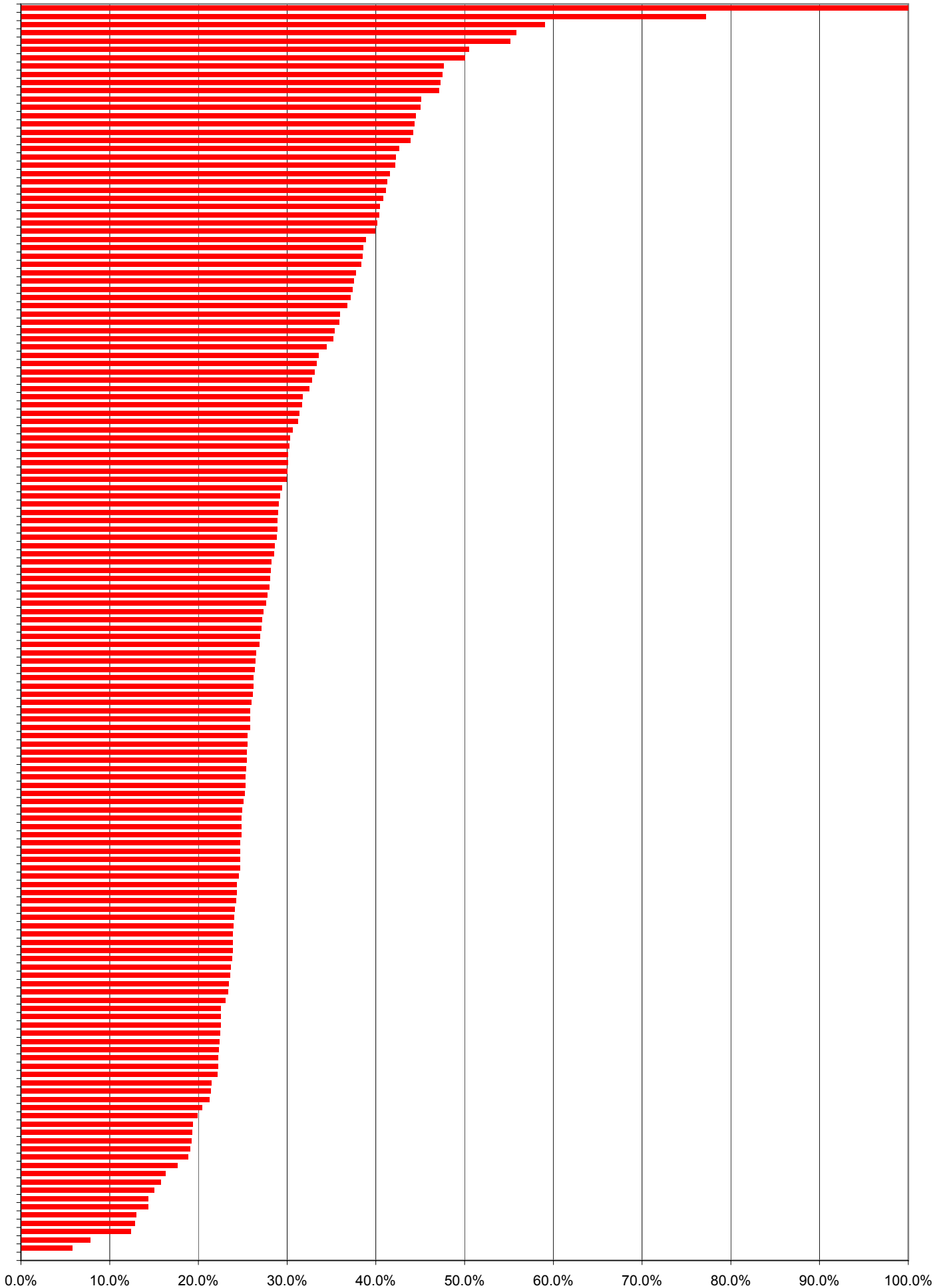

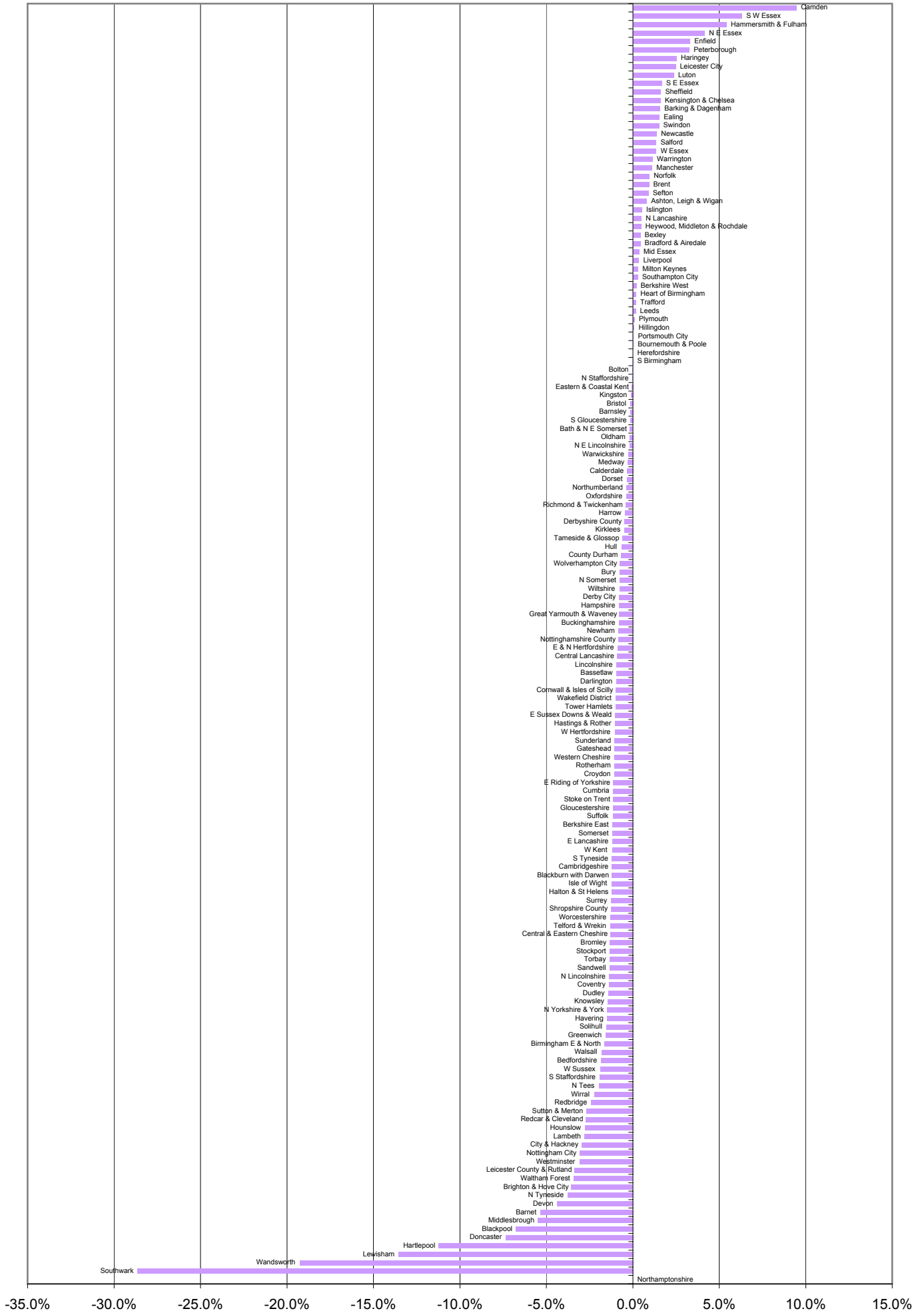
People aged 16 plus on GP reg. recorded as smoking in the last 15 months

by PCTs in England 2008/09 Q4 43/152 PCTs



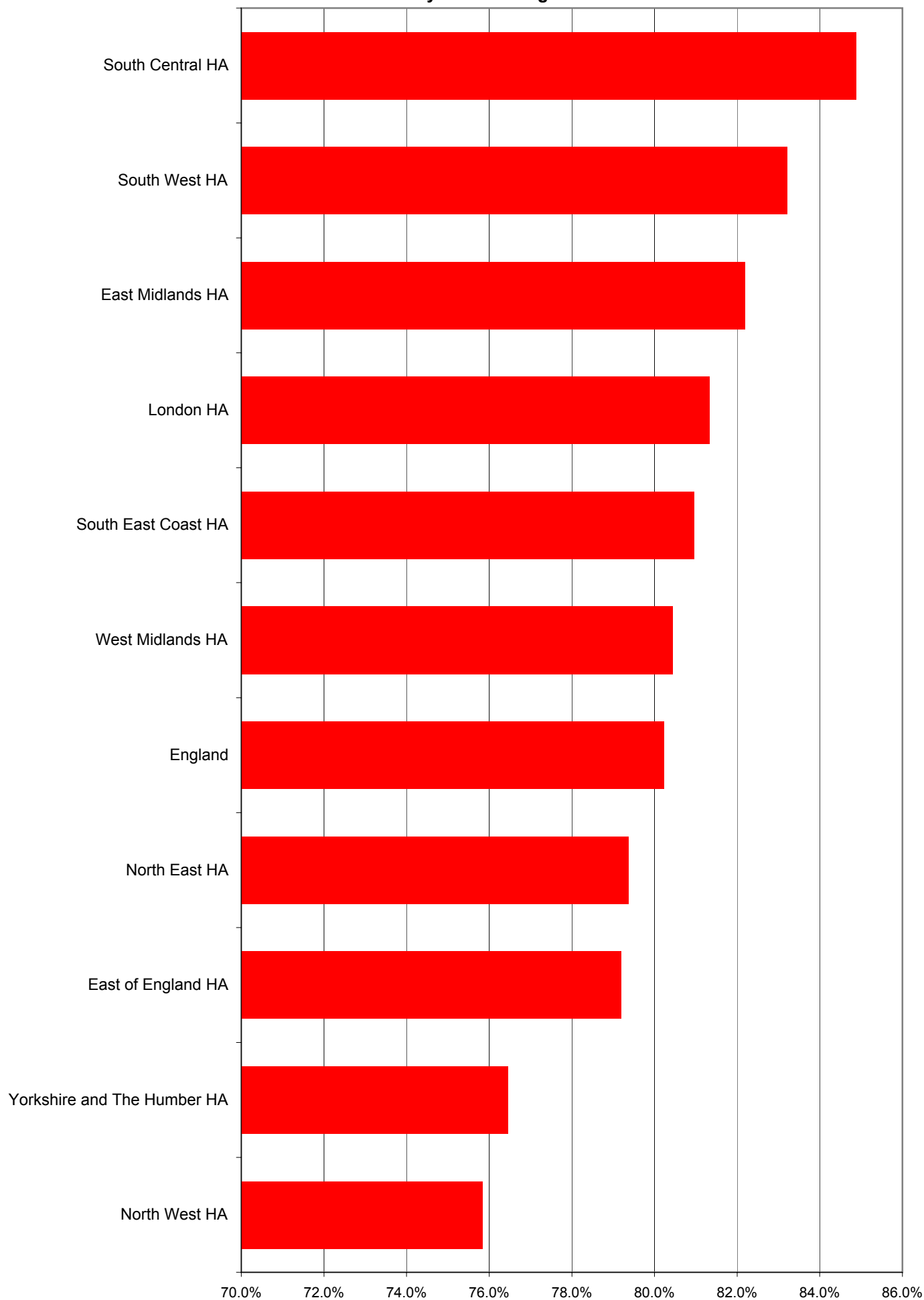
