Mothers Initiating Breastfeeding

The Priorities and Planning Framework contains a target for breastfeeding to deliver an increase of two percentage points per year in the initiation rate, focussing especially on women from disadvantaged groups.

The Infant feeding survey 2005 states that, 77% of mothers in England initially breastfed their babies. This is up 6 percent from the 71% as reported in the previous Infant feeding survey of 2000. LDPR Breastfeeding initiation data has been collected for four years. First via Strategic Executive Information System (STEIS) and more recently via the Data collection tool that is part of Unify, a web based system set up by the Department of Health to collect performance and other central returns directly from the NHS.

For the breastfeeding Local Delivery Plan Return (LDPR), each Primary Care Trust (PCT) is required to submit three figures at the end of each quarter: the number of maternities, the number of mothers initiating breastfeeding and the number of mothers not initiating breastfeeding. Lines 7101, 7102 7103. All three numbers must be submitted as integers. Logic suggests that the following rules should apply to each of the types of data collected; Quarter actual, Year to date and Forecast outturn.

Number initiating Breastfeeding	+	Number not initiating Breastfeeding	<=	Number of Maternities
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There are a number of reasons why a PCTs LDPR data can fail the routine validation checks. If the number of maternities is lower than the number recorded breastfeeding plus the number recorded not breastfeeding then the data is inconsistent and the PCT will be challenged by the department to revise their data. If the number of “not known”s is greater than 5% then, for statistical reasons, we are not able to report these figures. In these cases, the cells in the attached spreadsheet are left blank. However, even after the challenge data from a few PCTs remained inconsistent and not knows greater than 5%. All validation checks must be passed in order for the data to meet departmental statistical requirements.

For data quality reasons, it has not been possible to set a firm baseline or target for mothers initiating breastfeeding. History shows that the data quality of the performance indicator improves during the year and is better at quarter four since the data is then used to assess Healthcare Commission performance ratings. At Outturn 2006/07, 138 out of 152 PCTs submitted data that met the minimum data quality standard. (At 2006/07 Quarter 3 PCTs were restructures reducing their number from 303 to 152).

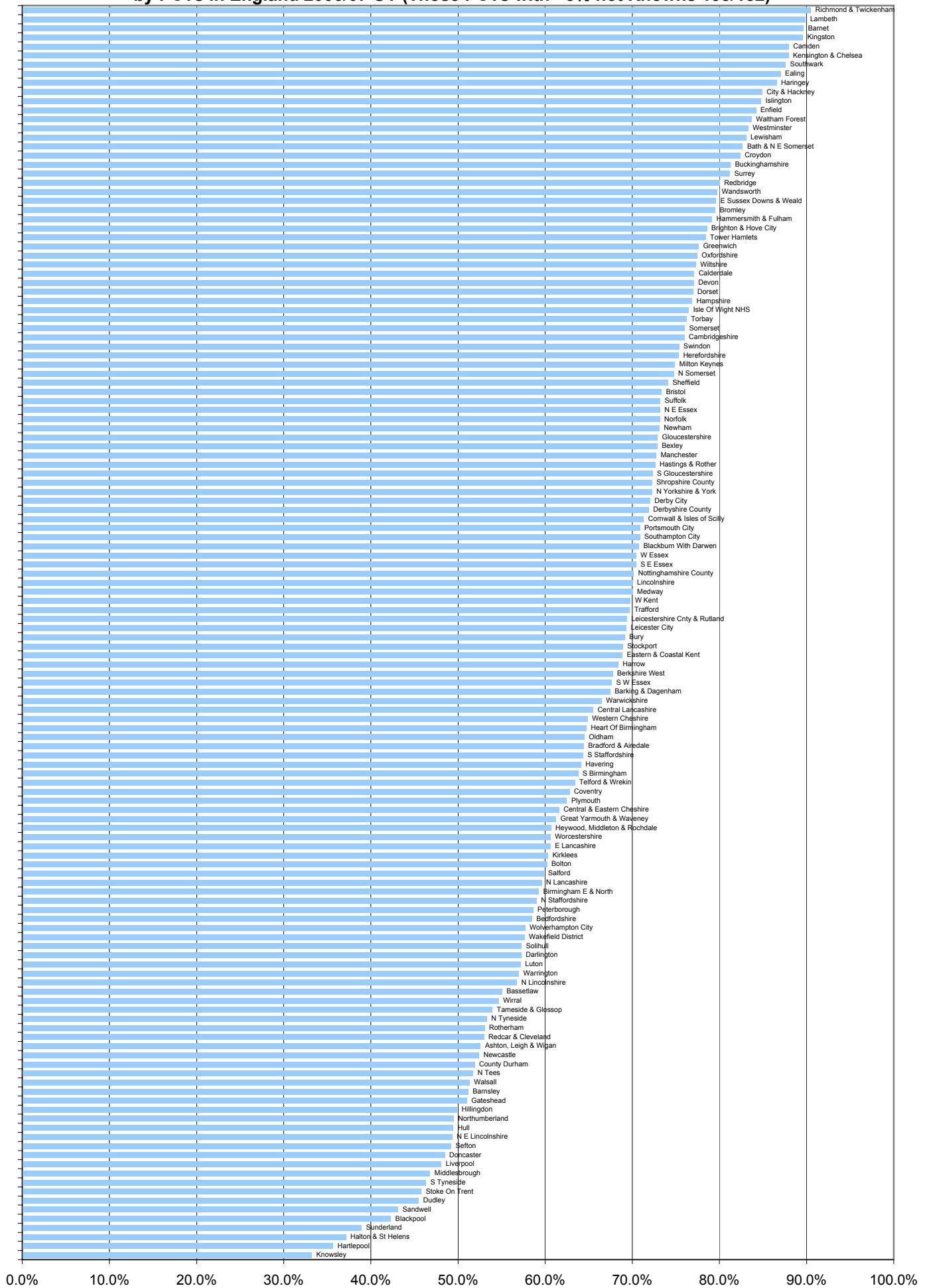

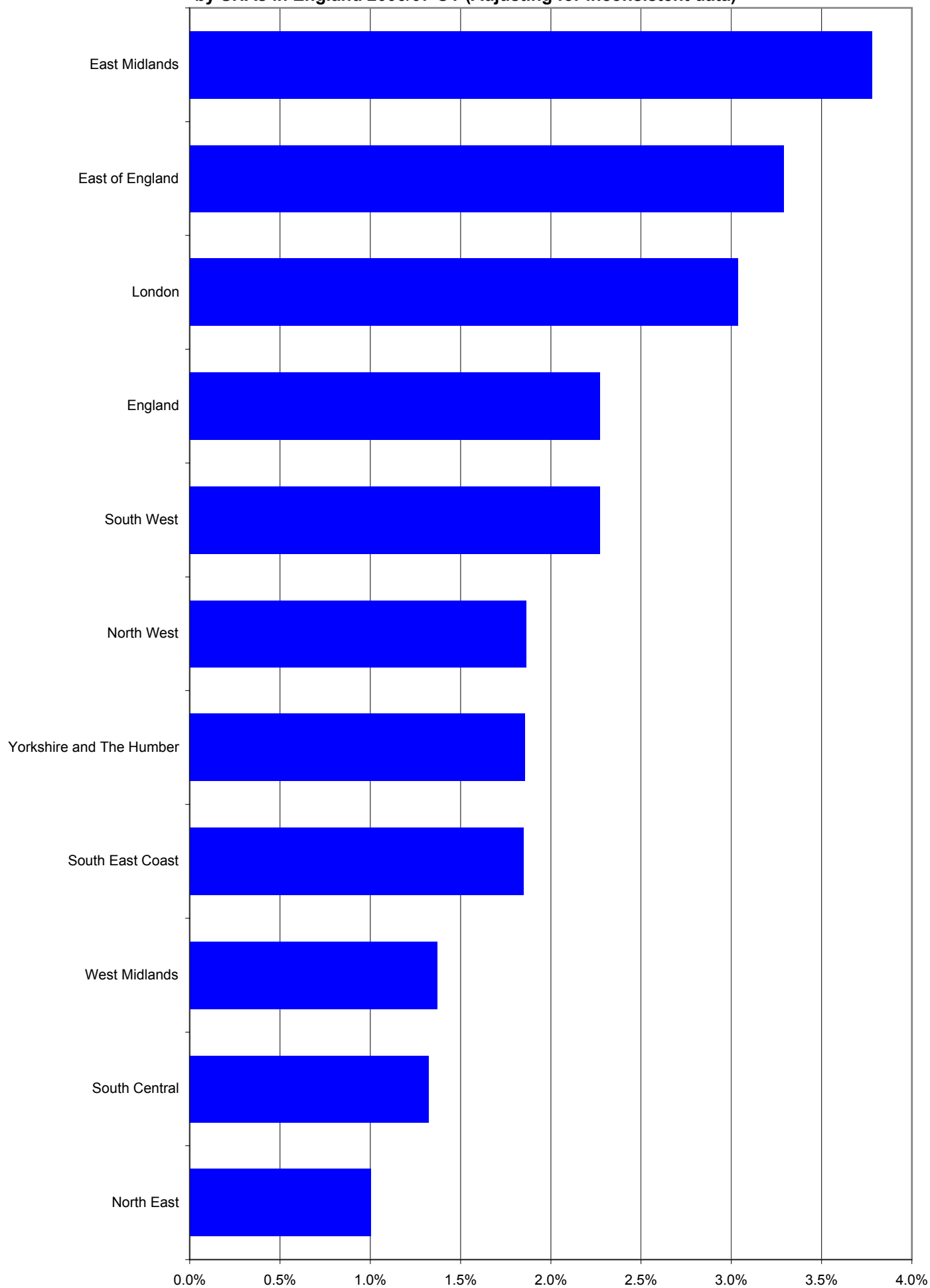

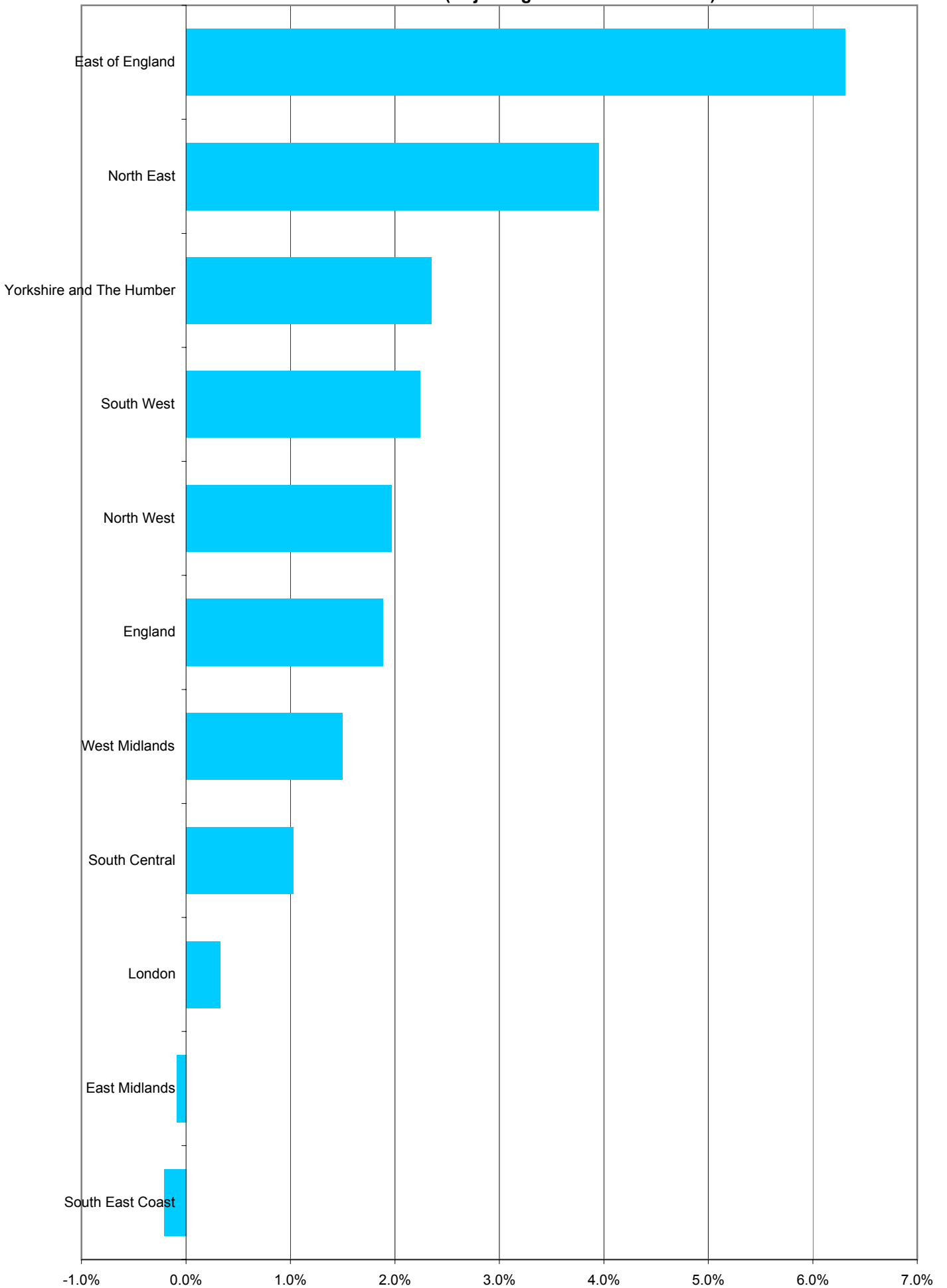
